Mrs. Gabrielle Stewart Mulliner, the lawyer's wife who recently returned from a six month's visit in London, declared Englishwomen were libelled in the persistent statements made by Americans that they were given to cigarette smoking.

"A man who does not smoke himself must be a weakling. I should think the young woman was fortunate in not marrying him. "I think a man is justified in breaking off with a young woman addicted to smoking. Any woman who works among little children can readily understand how a man would not want the mother of his children to smoke, and certainly children would not want to see their mother smoking. This cigarette habit among women is vicious."

"The medical fraternity has proved that the nicotine contained in cigarettes is injurious, not only to men, but even more so to women, not so accustomed to their use. For this reason, if nothing else, women should not indulge in such a habit."
