

HUSBAND BELIEVED TO HAVE LOST SUIT

Experts Testify John Bancroft, 3d, May Have Been Legitimately Born.

COUNTER CHARGE IS MADE

Wife's Suit Will Be Dropped When Court Decides Against Spouse, Is Belief—Judge Has Suspicion of Collusion.

WILMINGTON, Del., Jan. 18.—(Special.)—The taking of testimony in the suit of John Bancroft, Jr., for a divorce from Madeline Du Pont Bancroft ended in Superior Court chambers late this afternoon. A decision probably will be given the latter part of February. Just before the close today an agreement was reached by the attorneys and the court whereby there will be no oral argument. Each side will submit briefs February 1 and supplemental briefs will be filed February 5. It is generally believed that a divorce will be granted to Bancroft. It is also the understanding that when the court gives its decision to this effect the counter-suit of the wife will be dropped. The principal reason, it is said, why the court probably will decide against Bancroft is its suspicion of collusion all through the trial.
