

HUGE COLLAPSED STEAMER BEAVER

Wave Wrecks 2 Staterooms as Craft Enters Mouth of Columbia River.

NO PASSENGERS INJURED

Great Force of Water Smashes in Doors and Panels but Fails to Do Other Damage—Journey North Otherwise Smooth.

One of the freakish waves that are frequently reported by mariners on the Columbia River has managed to be capering about as the steamer Beaver, flagship of the San Francisco & Portland line, crossed in yesterday morning.

The Beaver crossed in yesterday morning, and as a consequence staterooms on the port side all received a drenching, while the panels in two of them, No. 49 and No. 52, were badly splintered.

Water Cores in Door. Stateroom No. 42, being farthest aft, apparently received the brunt of the weight for both panels of the door were torn out, also the plaster through the center.

Professor W. H. Lawrence and E. B. Pratt Make Discovery That Means Great Saving to Orchardists.

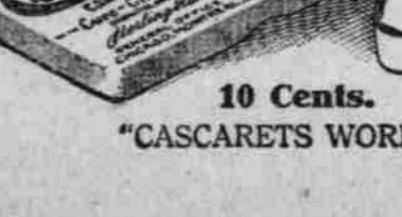
HOOD RIVER, Or., March 18.—(Special)—The discovery by Professor W. H. Lawrence and E. B. Pratt, of the pomological department of the United States Department of Agriculture, that the decay of apples in cold storage is due for the most part to the attack of the spores of anthracnose, and that the remedy is to spray with a Bordeaux mixture, will mean the saving of many hundreds of dollars to the fruit-growers of Western Washington and Oregon.
