CONSERVATION IN FAVOR Association Outlines Plans and Discusses Laws Needed. That greater efforts will be devoted to the work of educating the people of Oregon to the importance of the economical use of the natural resources of the state this year than ever before, was the unanimity of opinion expressed at the annual meeting of the Oregon Conservation Association held Monday night. The association will urge a more general understanding of the subject of con-

servation, believing that the future prosperity of the state will depend largely upon the practical use of the state's resources. Resolutions were passed urging the Oregon members of the House of Representatives to support the Senate bill providing for an appropriation of \$50,000 to be used in the work of salmon propagation in waters controlled by the Government. The association also adopted a resolution favoring amendment of the law governing the hunting of big game. The association desires that the open season be not earlier than September 1. The present law permits hunting of big game after August 1, at a time when danger of forest fire is greatest. Intelligent
