

SHANE LESLIE ILL; WEDDING DELAYED

Miss Marjorie Ide, Daughter of Minister to Spain, Not to Marry Until Fall.

DATE FIRST FIXED FOR JUNE

Illustrious Irishman Not in Serious Condition, but Is Run Down by Heavy Work in Lecture Tour of Country.

BALTIMORE, April 14.—(Special.)—What was to have been one of the most important and interesting of the June weddings—that of Miss Marjorie Ide, the daughter of Henry C. Ide, Minister to Spain, and Shane Leslie, the son of Colonel and Mrs. John Leslie, is now to be postponed because of the rather serious illness of the prospective bridegroom.

Mr. Leslie is one of the most ardent advocates of the Gaelic revival and he has been touring the country in the interest of the Irish language and making many speeches thereon. His lecture tour has been a long and exacting one and he has broken down and is suffering from what is spoken of as a "mild form" of nervous prostration.

Condition Not Serious. Mr. Leslie's condition is not at all serious, but his recovery must necessarily be extremely slow. Therefore, according to his father, all arrangements for the wedding are at an end temporarily, and it probably will be away along in the Autumn before any dates can be considered.

Miss Ide's engagement was announced recently, and at the same time the announcement was made that Minister Ide and his daughter were about to return from Spain to this country and might be expected to arrive in the latter part of this month. Miss Ide is a sister of Mrs. Burke Cockran and it was planned that the ceremony was to take place at the Cockran seat, the Cedars, at Port Washington, on Long Island, about June 1. Now these arrangements will have to be cancelled because the young lady is so enthusiastically in love with her fiancé that she has proved too much for his bodily health.

TWO FAITHS INCONSISTENT

Synagogue Warned Against Undermining of Faith From Within.

BALTIMORE, April 14.—The trend of American Judaism and its use in the preservation and growth of the religion of Israel constituted the message given today to the Central Conference of American rabbis here by its president, Samuel Schick, of New York.

As the religious leaders of the synagogue we naturally take this opportunity to congratulate the National Government and through it the American people upon the clear enunciation of the principle that the United States cannot allow any discrimination to be made by its government in the granting of citizenship because of distinctions of race or creed.

While the Jew becomes a member of the synagogue by birth and remains potentially a member of it, though he may not become formally a member, he remains a Jew as long as he does not formally adopt any other religion, and he must be considered as such until he takes any steps which formally put him out of the synagogue.

Membership Not Compatible. Membership in the synagogue is incompatible with formal membership in a Christian Science church even as such membership would be incompatible with membership in any other Christian denomination.

While the Jew becomes a member of the synagogue by birth and remains potentially a member of it, though he may not become formally a member, he remains a Jew as long as he does not formally adopt any other religion, and he must be considered as such until he takes any steps which formally put him out of the synagogue.

BANKERS IN JAIL

New Orleans Financiers Are Accused of Fraud.

Books False, Is Charge

Eugene F. Bahler, President, and Joseph H. Conilla, Director, Are Arrested—Former Assistant Cashier Accused of Theft.

NEW ORLEANS, April 14.—Eugene F. Bahler, president of the Teutonia Bank & Trust Company, of New Orleans, and Joseph H. Conilla, a director, were arrested here today charged with making false statements to the bank examiner and concealing the true condition of the bank.

Frank J. Braud, a former assistant cashier of the same bank and now a public accountant, was arrested at the same time, charged with embezzling \$8600 of the bank's funds. The arrests were made after an investigation by District Attorney St. Clair Adams. The bank is a state institution.

A committee from the New Orleans Clearing-House has investigated what steps should be taken if assistance is needed. Ex-Assistant Cashier Braud severed his connection with the bank more than a year ago, and it is charged that President Bahler and Director Conilla attempted to cover up his alleged shortage when the bank was examined some time ago by the State Bank Examiner.

President Bahler is prominent in local financial and social circles. He is president of the Teutonia Loan & Building Company, and a director of a local insurance company. The Teutonia bank has a capital stock of \$200,000, with \$77,220 surplus and undivided profits.

FLOOR BREAKS, TWO DIE

More Than 20 Hurt in Accident in Church.

Nearly 300 Persons Precipitated to Basement of Edifice at Harrington Park, N. J.

HARRINGTON PARK, N. J., April 14.—Two persons were killed and more than a score injured, several seriously, when the collapse of the floor of the Church of Our Lady of Victory precipitated nearly 300 persons into the basement.

The church was only partly completed and the assemblage there today was in connection with the ceremonies of laying the cornerstone.

The collapse of the floor came while an address was being made by Father Delahanty, pastor of the church. Suddenly the floor was heard to creak and then it went down with a crash.
