

DESERVED WOMER TELLS OF BATTLE

Mrs. Gawley Believes She Has Won 25-Year Fight for Wife's Right.

TRUANT TRACED FOR YEARS

Woman Positive of Identification of James McCauley as Husband Who Left Her With Three Children to Support.

"No task is too great for a woman if she really sets her mind to it and it is right. Persistence, patience and aggressiveness will win any fight."

This is the declaration of Mrs. James E. Gawley, of Detroit, who has identified to her own satisfaction James E. McCauley, of 1089 East Grant street, as her husband who deserted her in Holgate, O., 25 years ago and for whom she has persistently hunted ever since.

Mrs. Gawley last night told the story of her quarter century fight against odds and explained her reasons.

"It started 25 years ago," said Mrs. Gawley. "I was married in 1873 and had three children. My husband, the man against whom I have brought suit in the County Court, was a filer in sawmills and was much away from home, which was in Holgate, O."

"Twenty-five years ago he went to Williamsport, Pa., on one of his usual trips and remained away about two months. He then disappeared and went to Chatham, Ontario, where I learned later that he ran away with another man's wife and young son. He returned to me a short time later and stayed a few days. He then departed for Charlestown, Va., and that was the last time I saw him."

"Left with three minor children to support, I at once took up the fight to force him to support me. After much searching and work, he was traced to a small town near Charleston, where it was found he had changed his name to McCauley."

"Hector Gawley, a half-brother of James, learned that my husband was living with the woman with whom he eloped in Canada. He pleaded with Hector to keep quiet about the conditions he found and the brother agreed to do so provided the deserted wife and children were supported."

"But he did not send me money and it was necessary for me to continue the fight. James Gawley again disappeared and again went to work, but he was traced to Tacoma and Seattle and other Washington towns, searching for him, but my efforts failed."

"Patience and persistence were necessary. I had offers to marry, but refused. I had a fight to win and I couldn't win if I married. I heard that my husband was in New Orleans and again got in communication with him."

"Arrangements were made for him to join me in Detroit and take up life where we left off. I went to Detroit. He did not come. He was making plans to go away a month later. That was 14 years ago. I could not learn from where this renegade came."

"By hard work I learned he was in Washington after that and I am convinced he was in the West when he was supposed to have been in New Orleans."

"Hard Roads Encountered. "Everything seemingly was going wrong. I sewed, washed and did all kinds of odd work to support my children all this time. The money he sent didn't go very far. I had to fight without money."

"Twelve years ago I lost trace of my husband completely. These 12 years of persistence were rewarded when information as to his whereabouts. Through friends in Michigan I learned that he was in Portland. I did nothing at the time, but was making plans to come to Portland six weeks ago to continue my fight. My son, who has grown to manhood, came here a week later and with me we went to the McCauley residence."

"Great changes had taken place during the years of my fight. I had been too busy to grow old, but my husband was aged and bent. He denied his identity, but there was not a particle of doubt in my mind. His half brother, Hector, came here from California and we too, identified my husband."

"Old Habits Tell Tale. "Age had not taken away his habits, and that is where my convictions were made positive. As he turned away from me as I stood on the street near his home and accused him he twisted his body and placed his hand in his pocket, the same as he used to when I knew him as a young man in Holgate."

"I believe my fight is won. I am here to demand my rights as this man's legal wife. I am here to collect for the years of life he has tried to raise his children. I claim under the law a half interest in all his property. I understand he has sold some property. I have signed a deed and I demand my part of the proceeds."

"His children are all grown. His son is 32. He has two daughters, one a widow with two children, the other married with four children. He has eight grandchildren."
