RIGLER ISSUE IS UP Election Vote May Show Superintendent's Strength.

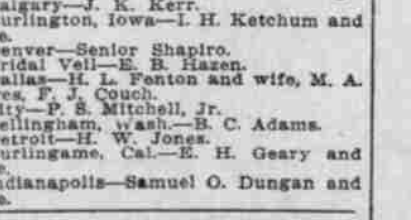

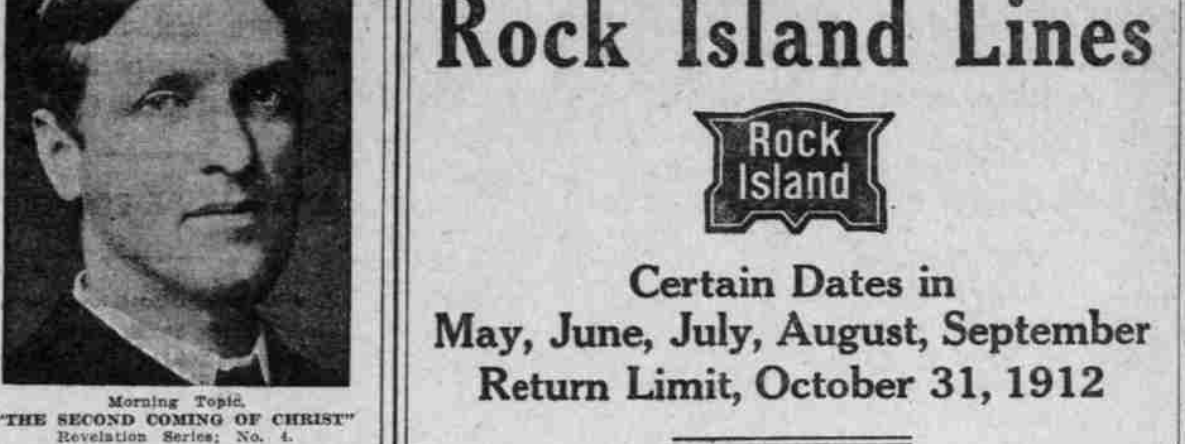
