COURT FINDS ERROR. Rader Case Reversed by Supreme Justices.

CRIME CHARGED IS ARSON. Appeal Taken From Grant County and New Trial Ordered on Grounds That Irrelevant Testimony Was Admitted.

SALEM OR., May 28.—(Special.)—The Supreme Court today in an opinion by Justice McBride reversed the action of the State against Frederick Rader, and remanded it for a new trial.
