TARDINESS DRAWS FINE

Old Offender Pays \$25 Rather Than Forfeit Bonds of \$100.

After years of periodical arrests with varying fortunes in the outcome, George Simpson, keeper of a Burnside-street lodging-house, "stuffed his toe" yesterday, through one of the most peculiar situations that ever arose in Police Court here. Though all the evidence against him had disappeared, as is usually the case when Simpson is involved, the defendant found himself in the dilemma of having forfeited his bail, with no recourse unless he consented to plead guilty and pay a fine. "I'd rather pay \$25 than \$100," he said, with a wry face, and it was so ordered. Last Sunday a transient named Schultz complained that he had been assaulted by Simpson, and the lodging-

housekeeper was arrested.

The case was called shortly after court convened Monday morning, and there being no appearance, the bail of \$100 was declared forfeited. A few minutes later Simpson and his attorney appeared and asked to have the case reopened. Meantime the complaining witness had disappeared. Judge Taxwell, knowing Simpson's record, refused to reopen the case unless he pleaded guilty and paid a fine, and to save \$75, Simpson did so.

BONIFACE QUITS OFFICER

"Moral Squad" Policeman Tells the Court He Was Assaulted.

E. W. Jackson, proprietor of the Jackson apartments in Union avenue, yesterday appeared in Municipal Court to answer a charge of assault and battery upon Patrolman Wardle, a member of the "moral squad." The officer, in quest of immorality, was summarily ejected from Jackson's house, and retaliated with a warrant which he served himself. Jackson says he resented a charge made by the officer that Mrs. Jackson was protecting an immoral person in the apartments. "I pushed him out, Your Honor," said the defendant, "but I didn't use force enough to break an egg. I told him to come with proper papers and he could get anyone in the house."

MILWAUKIE, Or., June 20.—(Special.)—J. W. Gracie, who was re-elected a member of the board of directors by a vote of 3 to 1, said this morning that he considers the vote an indorsement of the purposes of the directors in the selection of the two-acre site for a central high school, and that the purchase will be completed in due time.

At present there is pending a restraining order which prevents the board from acting, but so far there has been no hearing in the court.

Mother and Baby Cause Commotion in Municipal Court.

A swooning wife, a crying baby and a shame-faced husband-thief caused commotion in Municipal Court yesterday when the court and District Attorney refused to extend clemency to W. M. Tittus, who admitted carrying away every portable piece of furniture from a house in Woodlawn. While Mrs. O. J. McNamara, 1187 East Twenty-fifth street North, was kept from home by the serious illness of her baby, Tittus went to the place, smashed in the doors and carried away on his back the furnishings, even to a sewing machine and lounge. He was caught by Detectives Vaughn and Litherland, who lay in the grass awaiting his return for more loot. When the case was called the young
