Traffic to Be Barred at Midnight—New Structure May Be Opened Then.

CITY COUNCIL WILL DECIDE

Mayor Will Guarantee to Railway Rental Equal to 5 Per Cent of Cost of Upper Deck if Permission is Given.

The old Steel Bridge across the Willamette River, which has been a use for years, will be closed to all traffic at midnight next Friday night, and at that time it is expected the new steel railroad bridge will be opened to all traffic, streetcars and pedestrians.

The Mayor was in conference yesterday with J. D. Farrell, president of the O. W. R. & N. W. E. Angier, of Modjeski & Angier, bridge engineers, and City Attorney Grant.

Engineers Will Determine. It has been decided that Waddell & Harrington, engineers for the O. W. R. & N. W. E. Angier, will check up and determine the cost of the new bridge.

Work to Be Done. Mayor Ruslight says that it will be necessary to do some work at both approaches to the new bridge, but that on the East Side it is work which is for the city to complete.
