WESTCHESTER, Pa., Oct. 20.—Beneath an ancient oak in whose shade the gallant Lafayette once bled, the body of Senator Heyburn, of Idaho, was laid to rest this afternoon with ever increasing pomp.

The little meeting house was crowded to overflowing, many friends of the Senator having boarded the funeral train at Swarthmore.

Following the burial, Mrs. Heyburn and those who accompanied her returned to Washington by special train.
