CITY BANK IS PROPOSED

F. E. Coulter Says Portland Could Add to Its Present Income.

F. E. Coulter, who has been in the city for some time, has been making a study of the city's financial condition.

With a National bank established by the City of Portland under the Federal banking laws, Mr. Coulter said the city could do its own banking at a cost that would not only save expenses, but in interest, and could economize by floating the city's own bonds and keeping the money in circulation at home.

IRISH HONOR "MARTYRS"

Death of Allen, Larkin and O'Brien Is Commemorated.

In memoriam of the deaths of Allen, Larkin and O'Brien, the "Manchester martyrs," who were executed for treason by the English government November 23, 1867, 250 Irish men and women gathered in Woodmen of the World Hall last night and listened to an eloquent address delivered by Rev. Father E. J. Conaty, "Ireland's Place in History" was his subject, and eloquently he related the glorious traditions of Erin.

The execution of Allen, Larkin and O'Brien was denounced as nothing more or less than murder, the speaker maintaining that they were altogether innocent. A programme of patriotic Irish music and recitations was given. The meeting was held under the auspices of the Ancient Order of Hibernians.
