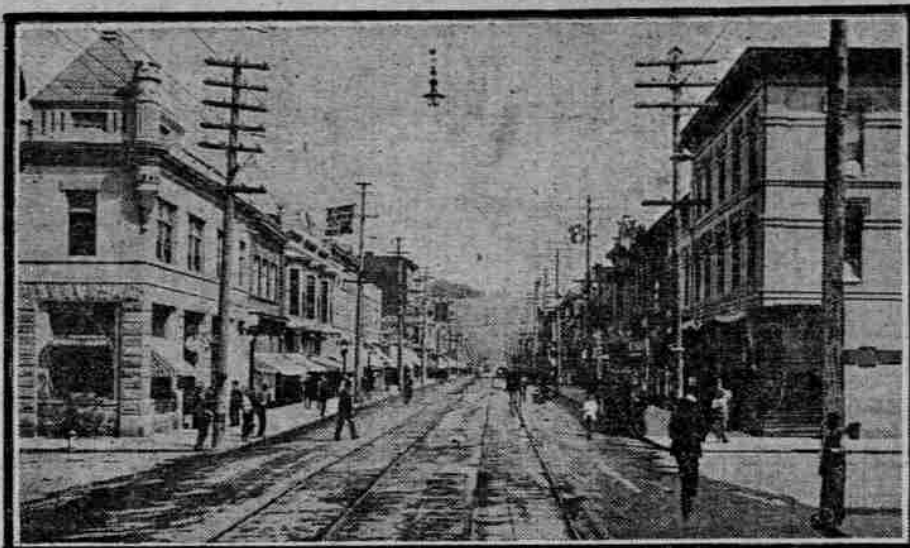


WILLAMETTE VALLEY OREGON. SHOWING ELECTRIC RAILROADS.

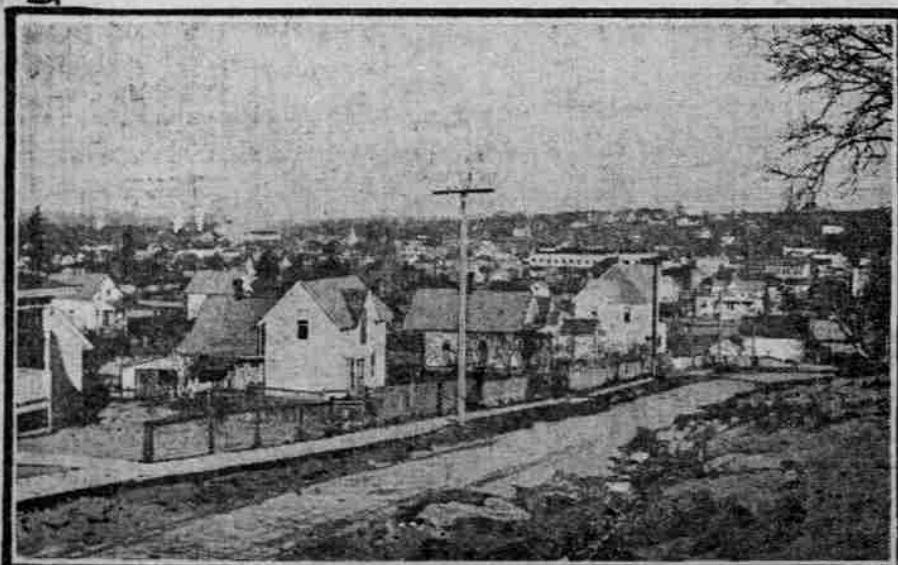
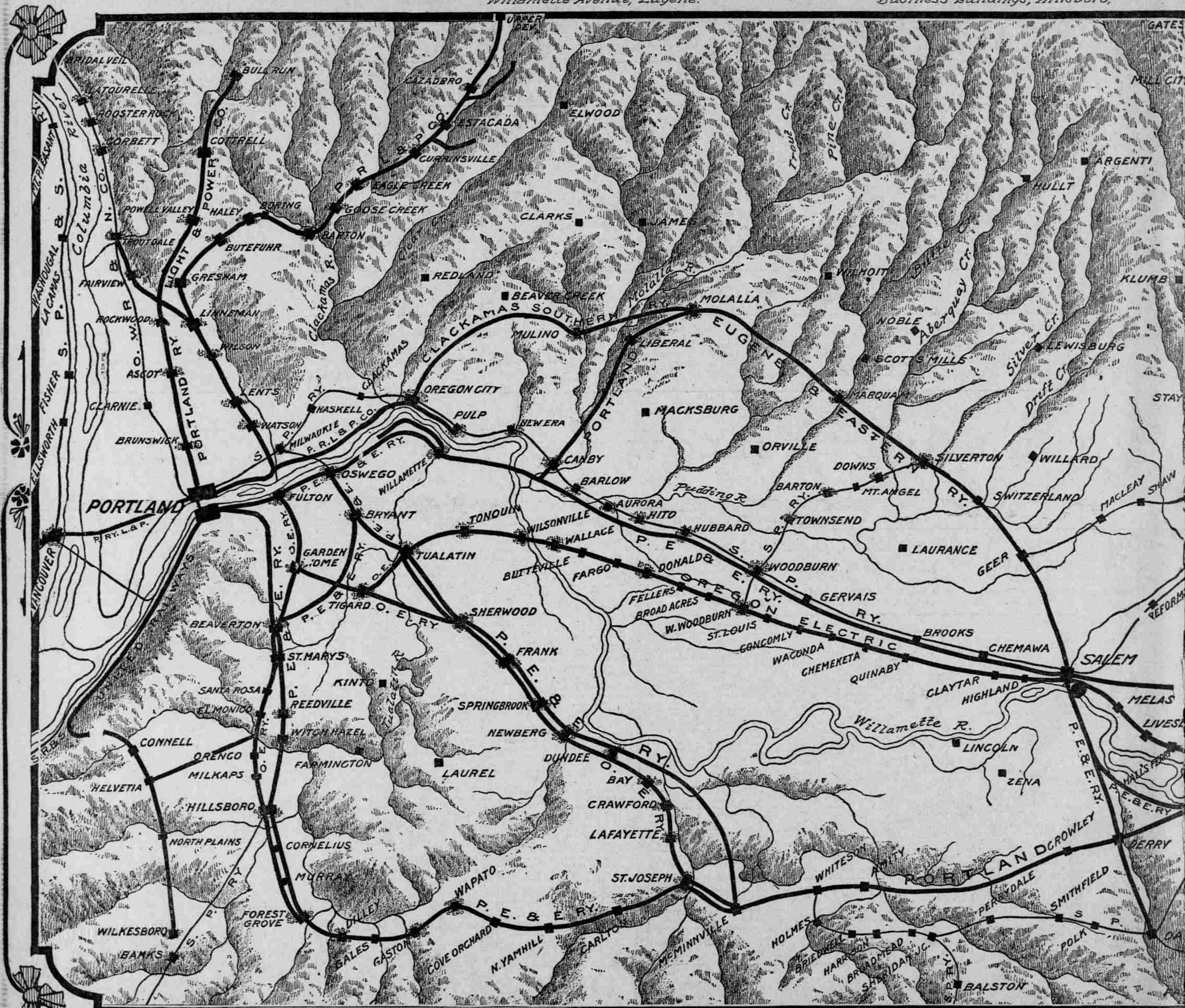
Heavy lines indicate electric interurban railroads built, under construction and authorized. Light lines are steam railroads. The electric roads are divided into the following systems: Portland, Eugene & Eastern (Harriman), 340 miles; Oregon Electric (Hill), 154.44 miles; Portland Railway, Light & Power Company (exclusive of city streetcar lines), 127.37 miles; United Railways (Hill), 33.93 miles; Clackamas Southern, 18 miles. Total, 673.74 miles. Border pictures show scenes in some of cities and towns served by these roads.



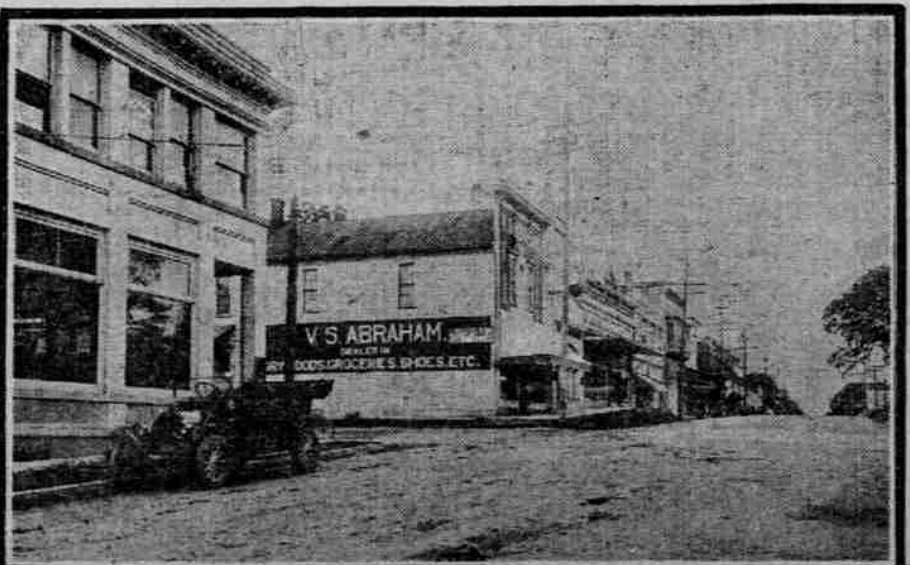

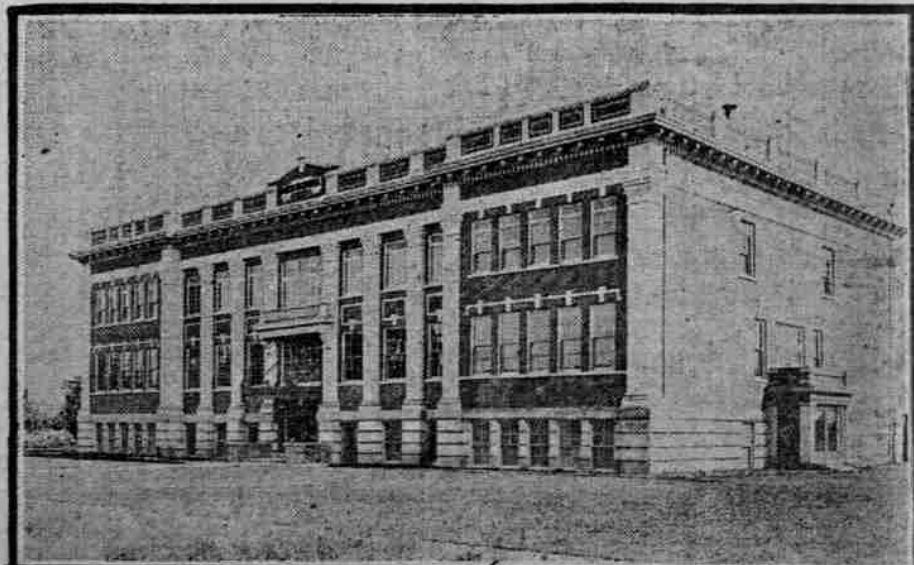
