MIMI'S BALLAST REMOVED

Work to Float Ship Began in March on "No Cure No Pay" Contract.

The four-masted German bark, Mimi, was first stranded on the night of February 13. It was about 3 o'clock when she struck and nearly 2 o'clock in the following morning when the life saving crew from Clatsop Beach got a line aboard and the first man was brought ashore.

Six Seen Against Sky.

The last seen of any of the men was just before dusk when six figures were seen silhouetted against the blue background on a part of the railing of the vessel protruding from the water.

The scene on the beach tonight is heart-rending. A crowd of persons numbering 1000 or more gathered from all over this end of the state and stood gazing into the lily blackness which held the secret of the fate of friends, relatives and acquaintances.

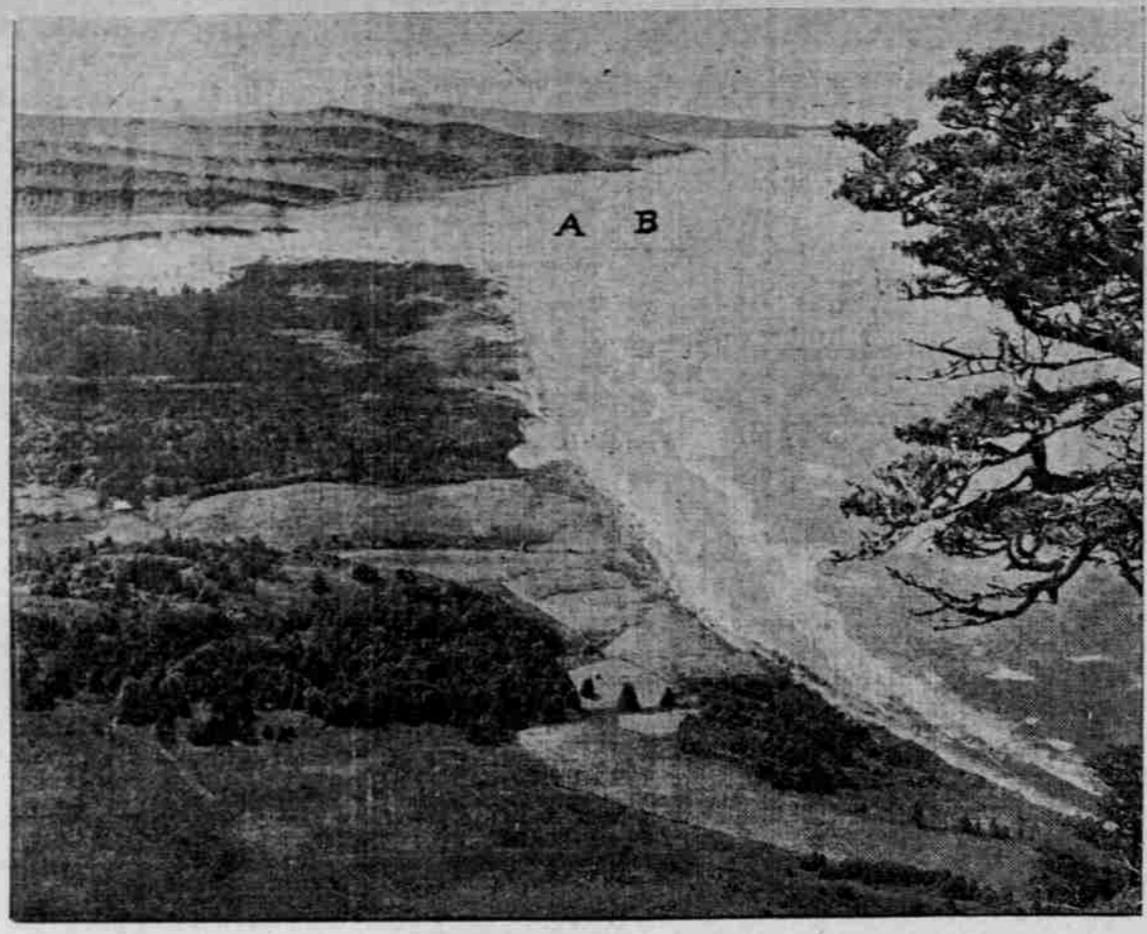

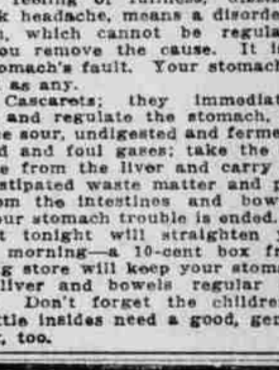

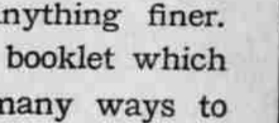
