DEFENSES EUROPE

World's Wheat Prices Made in Continental Markets.

EFFECT OF THE WAR SCARE

Supplies Being Accumulated in Anticipation of Possible General Disturbance—Assurance of Peace Would Mean Decline.

There was no wheat business to speak of under way yesterday in the local or country markets. Prices were nominal, but the undertone was firm as holders were not offering except on outside prices.

The demand from all quarters was exceedingly slack. The large millers are well supplied with wheat and the small mills in the interior are not buying and evidently have enough to carry them for the present. California buyers continue to hold back.

The future course of the market is a matter of speculation. Stocks in the Northwest are light and with an active trade could be easily wiped out, but some of the grainmen are convinced that this will not happen.

Tone Is Strong at Close of Stock Market.

GOOD GAINS ARE RECORDED

Favorable Crop and Copper Reports Are Important Factors—President's Message Has Small Effect on Trading.

NEW YORK, April 8.—After pursuing an uncertain course with prices first above and then below yesterday's closing range, the stock market developed strongly today and trading ended with a number of substantial advances.

Of the various influences brought to bear upon the market today, the President's message received first attention, but its effect upon the market was comparatively small. At the time of its delivery the list sold off sharply, but the movement was short-lived and the appearance of a bearish drive, timed to the hour of publication of the message, was quickly reversed.
