Demand for Export Flour at Lower Quotations.

MILLERS HOLDING FIRM

Oriental Situation is Clearing and if Terms Could Be Agreed Upon, Orders of Good Volume Might Be Booked.

If flour buyers and sellers could get together on prices, a good volume of trade with the Orient could be worked up. The spread of 10 to 20 cents between buyers in the local mills and purchasers for Far Eastern account, and neither side seems willing to make concessions yet.

Affairs in South China appear to be clearing, as private cables received yesterday were to the effect that the government is in control of the situation. It is taken for granted that the end of the revolution is not far off, and with this question settled and silver rising, orders from that quarter are being placed.

Shippers are hoping for a further reduction of 20 cents in trans-Pacific freights. It is pointed out that 80,000 tons of steamer space is available for all North Pacific routes including Vancouver, B. C., in September, and the lines cannot possibly fill this at the rates announced.

The wheat market continues inactive and weak. The demand is limited and not much is being offered.

New hay is beginning to come in freely and the market is easier. Prices are materially lower than a few weeks ago.

Receipts of hay yesterday were 23 cars and for the week to date 41 cars have arrived.

Weekly foreign wheat shipments were as follows: This week, last week, last year, Argentina, 38,000, 40,000, 320,000; Australia, 1,200,000, 1,000,000, 1,000,000.

Local receipts of wheat reported by the Merchants' Exchange are as follows: Monday, 10; Tuesday, 10; Wednesday, 10; Thursday, 10; Friday, 10; Saturday, 10.

Aside from an offer of 20% cents for an independent crop, there are no new developments in the hop market yesterday. The demand, on the whole, was small, and no contracts were signed up.

The weather in England was cloudy, according to the press cable. A private cable from London said: "Weather unfavorable. Market steady and firm. Crop prospects unchanged."

PEACHES ARE IN LARGE SUPPLY. Market is temporarily softened—Cannanapes Sell Quarter Lower.

The cantaloupe market was a quarter lower yesterday, with a better supply. Standards sold at 27 and 28 cents, 22 and 23 cents.

A fine crop of Thompson seedless grapes was received and they offered at \$1.75 a crate. Malaga in lug boxes sold at \$1.25 to \$1.50.

Most kinds of berries were in limited supply. Raspberries sold at \$1.30. Loganberries were slow at \$1. For blackberries, 90 cents was the top price on the farmers' market.

The first crop of sweet potatoes of the season is out from Merced and will arrive here Wednesday or Thursday. A car of Los Angeles tomatoes of fine quality, in lugs, was put on sale at \$1.25.

Foultry in Good Demand. There was a strong demand for poultry offered yesterday for local and shipping purposes, and prices held fairly firm.

All grades of refined sugar were advanced 10 cents a hundred yesterday. This change had been expected for several days, owing to the strength displayed by the Eastern market.

RECORD WHEAT CROP

Total Production Estimated at 744,000,000 Bushels.

SPRING GRAIN IMPROVING

Government Places Corn Yield at 452,746,000 Bushels Under Last Year's—Barley and Oats Are Doing Well.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 8.—The Government's August grain report, eagerly awaited because of the reported serious damage to corn from drought and other conditions, was issued at 2:15 P. M. today. It shows the condition of the principal crops on August 1, and estimates the yield for the production of each as follows:

Wheat—Total 744,000,000 bushels, compared with 695,900,000 last year. Winter wheat—444,900,000 bushels, compared with 429,100,000 last year. Spring wheat—299,100,000 bushels, compared with 266,800,000 last year.

Barley—Total 191,191,231 bushels, compared with 183,000,000 last year. Oats—Total 191,191,231 bushels, compared with 183,000,000 last year.
