Those who visit the fair should not fail to see the art department on the upper floor of the pavilion...

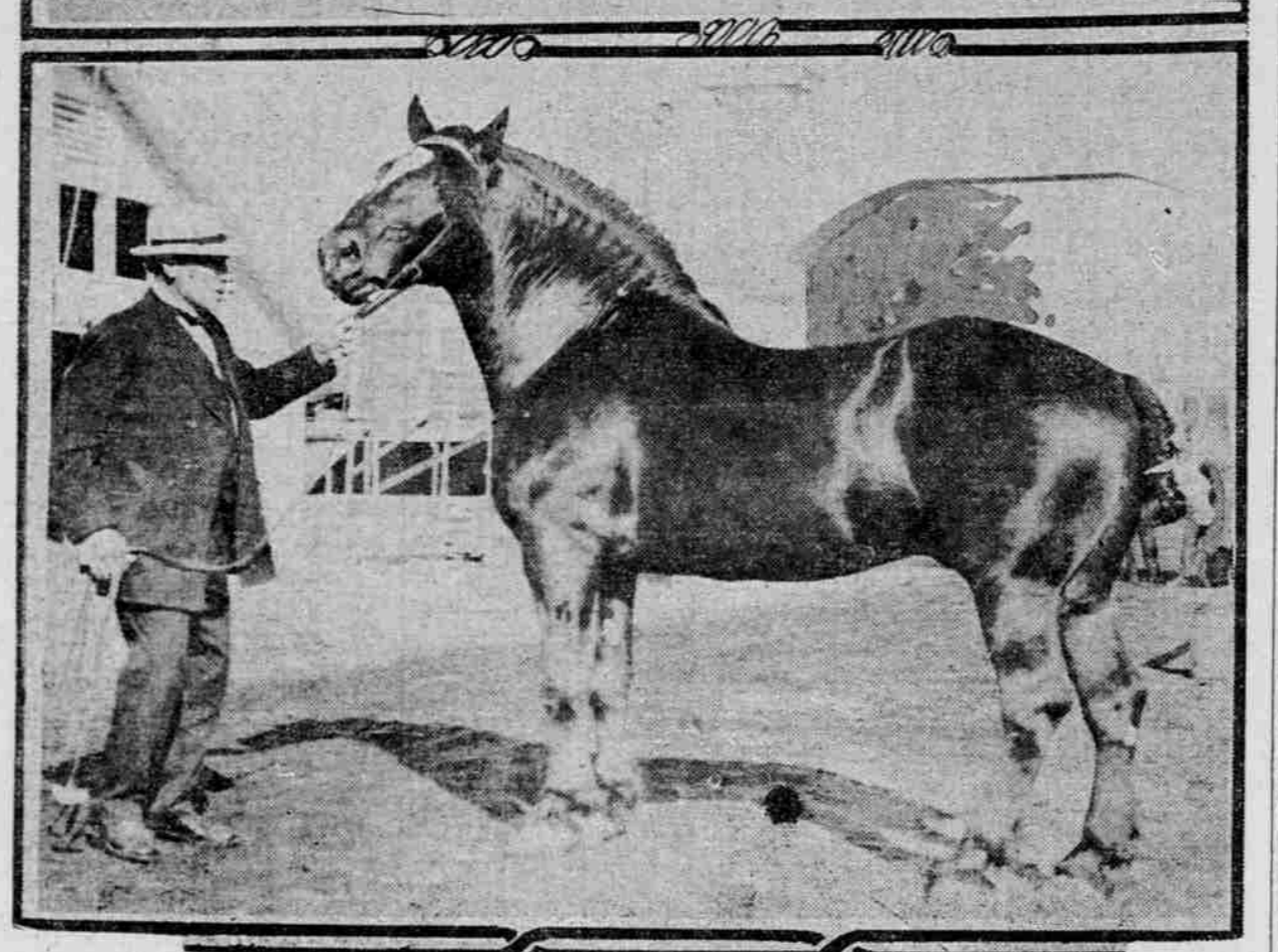
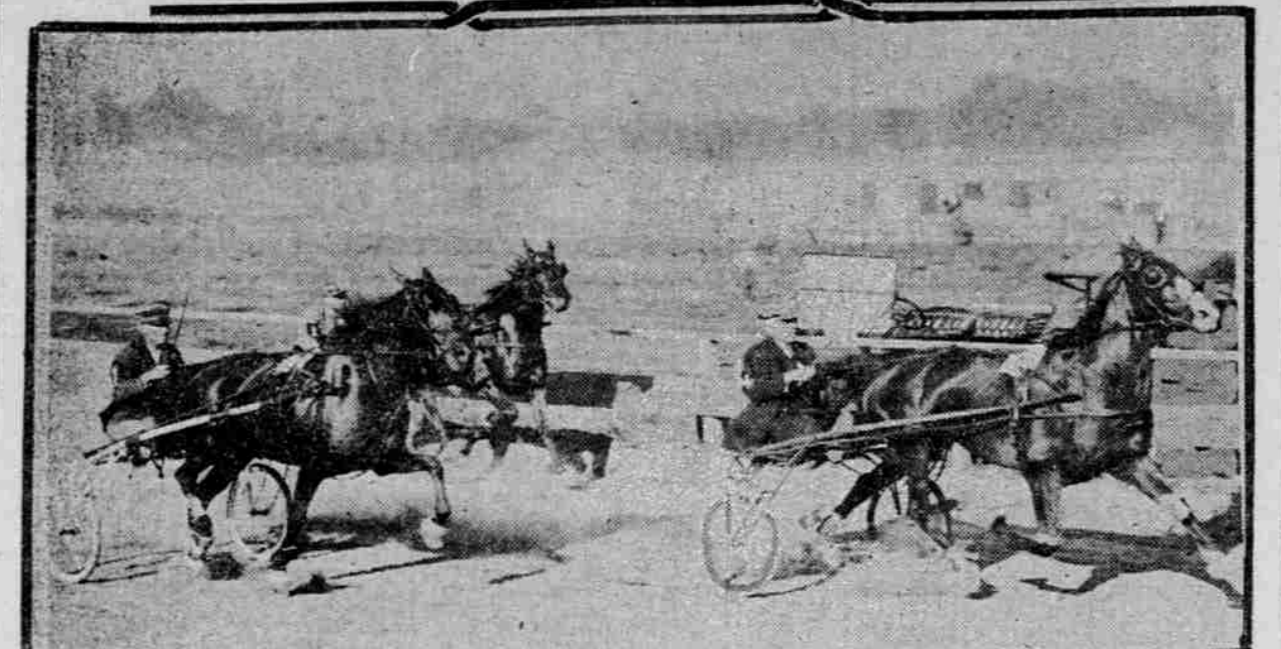
