Inquiry From England for Hops Is Reported.

UNDERTONE IS STRONG

Further Business Put Through at 24 Cents—Lower Grades Are Also Advancing in Price-Activity in Washington.

Interest in the hop market was further stimulated yesterday by the report of fresh inquiry from abroad. Coming on top of the keen demand from domestic sources, any important buying for European accounts can only have the effect of strengthening the market to a great degree.

The report from the valley that Durbin & Conroy had bid 24 cents for Newberg was significant, owing to this firm's connection with the great London house of Wigan Richardson & Co.

In addition to the Otto Hanson lot of 153 bales, at Oak Grove, which Joseph Harris bought Wednesday at 24 cents, Mr. Harris yesterday secured another lot of 85 bales at the same price.

Twenty-five cents was also paid by the Kola Nels Hop Company to James Linn for 58 bales. Offers of 24 cents were made by other dealers, but further acceptance at this price were reported.

Ralph Williams purchased about 100 bales at Dallas at 23 cents. A carload was secured by H. L. Hart at Silverton at 22 1/2 cents. The Shindler lot of 255 bales, at Salem, was sold to William Brown & Co., at 23 cents, and the Shaner lot of 91 bales at 22 cents. Grubbs bought the Dunavin crop of 174 bales at 22 1/2 cents.

The Washington market continued active. A 900-bale lot of ordinary grade Yakima, was sold at 22 cents, but the other details were not learned. James Pincus bought the Kohler, Pearson and another lot at Chehalis, aggregating 350 bales, at 23 cents. Choice hops are held higher in Washington, as in Oregon.

The following cable was received from London: "Market firmer for prime to choice, weaker for lower grades. Continental markets strong."

WOOL DEALINGS AT BOSTON LARGER

Higher Prices Have Been Secured on Some Choice Lots.

Wool trading on the Boston market has enlarged, particularly in territory grades. Among the sales reported in the past week were: 50,000 pounds of South Springs fine medium at 16 cents, Wyoming at 18 cents, Utah at 10 1/2 cents and Montana at 10 1/2 to 19 cents. A mail report says of the weekly trade:

"Contrary to the predictions, the market for wool shows a gain in activity. Conservative interests figure that upward of 4,000,000 pounds of wool have been distributed, while some dealers estimate the total business at fully 6,000,000 pounds the past week. The supply of domestic wool unsold has been reduced to such unusually low figures that difficulty is foreseen for those manufacturers who have not provided for their requirements for the heavyweight goods season."

"Higher prices than those secured at any previous time this season have been obtained on some choice lots of wool during the period mentioned. In fact the scarcity has become so apparent that the market shows a gradual tendency to strengthen. Estimates of a decline of 40,000,000 pounds in the domestic clip this year are now considered very conservative, though not a great white wool crop would have been thought radically large. Some dealers figure that the aggregate for the season will fall 60,000,000 pounds short of that last year."

WHEAT MARKET ON SOUND BASIS

Higher Prices Quoted in Some Quarters. Mill Feed Lower.

A firm undertone prevailed in the wheat market yesterday. Local dealers quoted as high as the full price on club, but higher bids were made in some quarters. The wheat quotation was maintained at 90 cents, though it is known that but little is available at this price. Trading in oats and barley was quiet.

The break in the San Francisco mill feed market, and liberal offerings by some of the mills in the North, have created an easier feeling here. Commenting on the situation, J. H. Klotzman said:

"California markets have gone all to pieces owing to large shipments from Portland and the Sound, something over 2000 tons having been shipped last week. GRAPES PASS STILL HAS GRAPES

File Shipment Received From Carson Vineyard—Orange Trade Active.

Poultry Supplies Are Increasing. Receipts of poultry of all kinds were heavy yesterday. Buyers were well filled upon chickens and would not offer over 14 cents for hens or Springs. Live turkeys were quoted at 20 1/2 to 21 cents. A good supply of dressed turkeys came in, but almost the only outlet was on the Sound.

Dressed turkeys were also large, but they cleaned up without trouble at steady prices. Conditions were unchanged in the egg, butter and cheese markets.

Cuban Sugar Output Larger. According to the estimates of H. A. Himes, one of the best authorities on the Cuban sugar production, the final figures for the 1912-13 sugar output of Cuba were: Of centrifugal, 16,775,102 bags and of molasses sugar 229,551 bags, making a total of 17,004,653 bags, or 2,065,270 tons. Western tons of 2240 pounds. This is in excess of the crop of 1911-12 by about 630,000 tons and is practically double the crop of five years ago.
