WORTHY to rank among the very finest hostleries in the United States, the Hotel Oregon represents the high type of building construction that is making Portland a modern and splendid metropolis. Erection of the Oregon was begun in 1912, it was completed early in 1913 and opened to the public on March 4. The Oregon is a monument to the faith in Portland of the owner, S. Benson, retired Oregon lumberman. The cost, including furnishings, was \$1,500,000.
