

FRANK P. WALSH ON "IN BAD" LIST ALSO

Like Caminetti, Industrial Commission Chairman Said to Have Wilson's Ill-Will.

UTTERANCES REASON GIVEN

Statement That Hundreds of Thousands of Men Cannot Find Employment Arouses President. Caminetti Vexes Bryan.

OREGONIAN NEWS BUREAU, Washington, Feb. 25.—Anthony Caminetti, Commissioner-General of Immigration, and Frank P. Walsh, chairman of the Federal Industrial Commission, have incurred the ill will of President Wilson, who appointed them, and there is a possibility that one or both of them may be dismissed in the "interest of the service." Caminetti is "in bad" because he went before the House committee on immigration and urged the immediate passage of a bill excluding Japanese and Hindu laborers from the United States. He made this recommendation after Secretary Bryan had appeared before the same committee and earnestly appealed to the members to postpone indefinitely legislation affecting the Orientals.

Mr. Walsh is "in bad" because he issued a circular to the newspapers in which he made the statement "hundreds of thousands of men in the United States, willing to work, cannot find employment." Several Republicans in the House of Representatives, in the course of partisan speeches, have made the same assertion credited to Mr. Walsh, and each time the statement was made by the Republicans it was promptly denied by Democratic leaders.

Democrats Are Chagrined. But now comes Mr. Walsh, the one man in the Federal service supposed to be informed on labor conditions in the United States, and asserts over his signature that hundreds of thousands of laborers are idle and cannot find employment. Thus the Republicans have official confirmation of their charges, and the Democrats have nothing to fall back on to substantiate their denials.

Secretary Bryan is very much disgruntled over the Caminetti testimony before the immigration committee, and it is said he regards Caminetti as guilty of rank insubordination. The secretary had much to do with securing Caminetti's appointment, but now he is the chief advocate of Caminetti's removal. Since it became known that Caminetti's job in Washington was insecure by reason of what he said with reference to the Japanese and Hindus, the intimation has been given that the Democrats of California may nominate him as their candidate for Governor.

Walsh's Backing Strong. And it may develop that the Administration will be content to gag Mr. Caminetti and allow him to retain his position until he deems it advisable to enter the California campaign.

If the more radical Democrats in Congress have their way Mr. Walsh of the industrial committee would be dismissed in very short order, but he has rather a strong backing and the President may allow him to continue in office, but in any event he is due for a sharp reprimand and a warning to be more careful as to the political character of information given out by his office.

Colonel George S. Young, post commander, will head the campaign for the "Go-to-Church Sunday" and will attend the meeting. Chaplain James Osseward will deliver the sermon. At 3 o'clock in the afternoon 24 field musicians will sound in unison the church call.

The ushers will be Sergeant Howard, Hospital Corps; Sergeants Tripp, of the non-commissioned staff, and Battalion Sergeant Birmele.

MANITOBIANS VISIT IN CITY

Premier Roblin and Other Distinguished Men En Route South.

For a rest after a strenuous session of the Manitoba Parliament, Robert P. Roblin, Premier of Manitoba, and a party of distinguished Manitobans are on their way to Southern California in a private car of the Canadian Northern Railway. They stopped over at the Portland Hotel yesterday for a few hours.

With the Premier are his wife, Senator A. Bernard, J. A. Cameron, assistant superintendent of the Canadian Northern, and D. MacDonald, all from Winnipeg. They were joined at the hotel by F. T. Lindsay, of Winnipeg, who has been here several days and will remain for about three weeks longer before going south. The party will remain in California until the end of April.

PRINTING CASE PUSHED

Suit Involving Use of Union Label on State Matter to Go Up.

SALEM, Or., Feb. 25.—(Special.)—W. C. Francis et al. have filed an amended complaint against State Printer Harris, the State Printing Board and members of the Salem Typographical Union to enjoin the State Printer from employing only union men and using the union label on state printed matter.

Harris, January 6, abrogated a contract he had with the union, making the union stipulations and will ask that the suit be dismissed. He has given up hope of making the shop a union one at present at least.

The plaintiffs, however, will push the action to obtain a ruling from the supreme court.

GERMAN ADMIRAL CRITICAL

CHOOSING OF WORD STIRS FIRE

The word "inquiry" apparently aroused the ire of the German Admiral, who identified it even today with a claim to the right to cross-examine any German commander.

Admiral von Diederichs says he discussed the situation with the British commander and told him that he would shoot any officer attempting to carry out this order of Admiral Dewey.

A substantial victory for the Germans was claimed by Admiral von Diederichs in the final settlement, by which any arriving warship was to report itself to the American commander and afterward was required only to show his flag. According to the German Admiral, his call on the Spanish authorities was justified by the fact that no blockade had been proclaimed formally.

Before leaving Manila, Admiral von Diederichs and Admiral Dewey exchanged presents and cordial letters, burying the hatchet and blaming the newspapers for the friction.

Admiral von Diederichs said he had hoped the affair had been forgotten and Admiral Dewey's action in reviving the controversy in an erroneous statement was a matter of surprise and regret to him.

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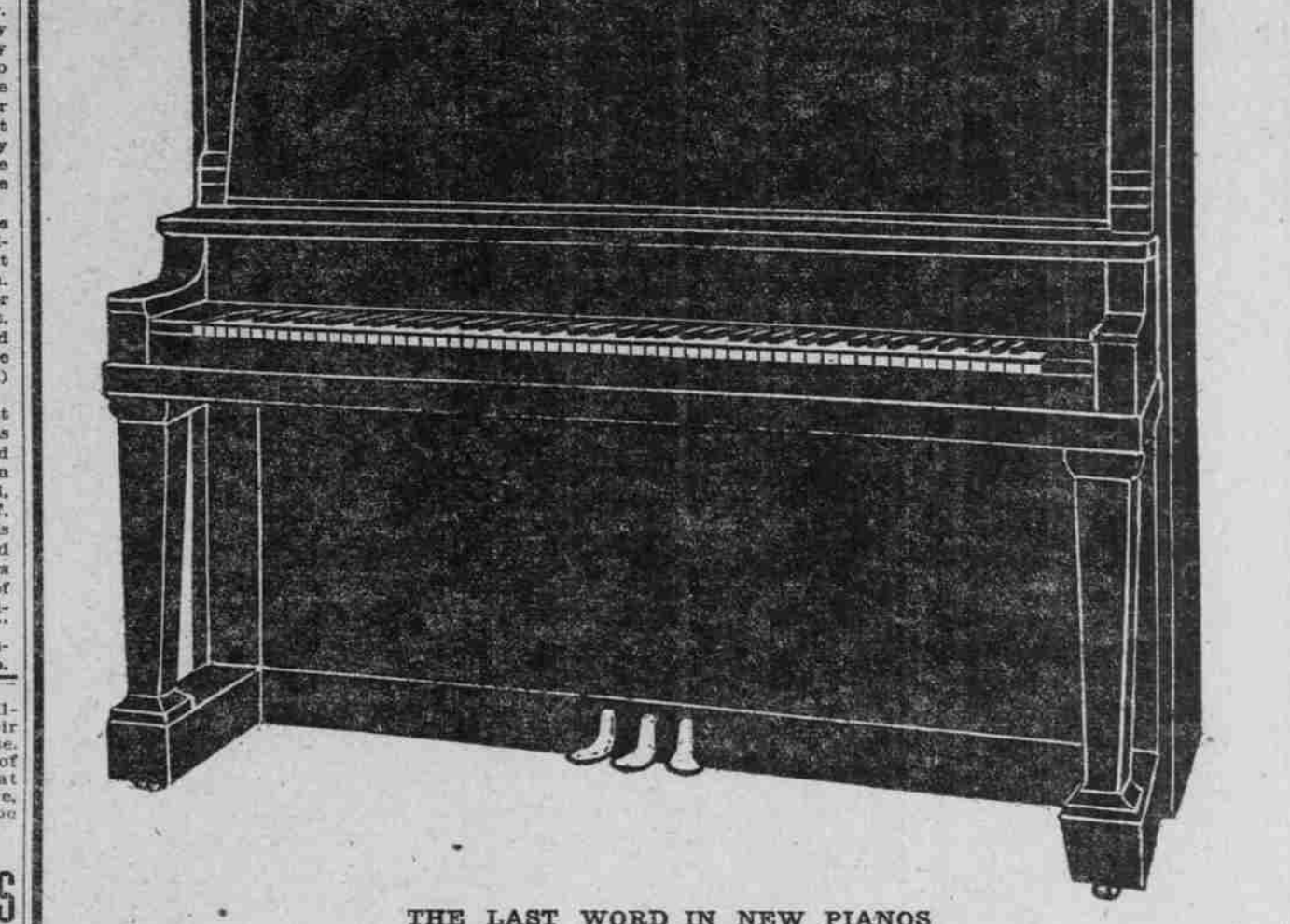
