Crop prospects up to this time have been very good in both Oregon and California. The latter state the crop is probably as safe now as it will be three months hence, but in the Northwest growers are hoping for a spell of clear, warm weather.

A late trade report from New York says: "Sellers of future California prunes are impressed by the crop conditions and have indicated that a much shorter crop than had been counted on. They are withdrawing recent quotations and their new figures are based on the crop conditions as reported."
