**MAZAMAS TO HIKE
 UP MOUNT RAINIER**

Journey to Top of Snow-Clad
 Mountain to Mark Club's
 21st Annual Outing.

ROUTE FOR TRIP SELECTED

Climbing Base Will Be Located in
 Moraine Park at Elevation of
 6000 Feet—Party to Leave
 Portland August 2.

The Mazama Club will hold its 21st
 annual outing on the north side of
 Mount Rainier. The climbing base will
 be located in Moraine Park at an elevation
 of 6000 feet. The party will leave
 Portland the evening of August 2, arriving
 in Tacoma the next morning, where it
 will be joined by parties from Puget
 Sound points. Going from Tacoma by
 special train, the party will arrive at
 Fairfax about 9 o'clock in the morning.
 From there the party will proceed to
 Independence camp.

Two days will be consumed in tramping
 the 18 miles to Moraine Park. The start
 will be made along the trail which
 follows the Carbon River. For the first
 three miles the trail is in the National
 Forest reserve, after which it crosses the
 western boundary of the Mount Rainier
 National Park. The party will proceed
 about three miles beyond the park
 entrance to the park rangers' station,
 where the river will be crossed on a
 pole bridge. Here a stop will be made
 for lunch.

The afternoon tramp will bring the
 climbers well into the high Cascades.
 At the end of a five-mile tramp
 Independence camp will be reached. The
 night will be passed at Independence
 camp.

Park to Be Reached.
 The next day the hikers will proceed
 to the snout of Carbon Glacier, where
 the Carbon River flows from beneath
 the ice. From here the route for the
 next mile is over the glacier itself.
 Then begins the final five miles, a
 climb of 3000 feet into Moraine Park.
 From this camp Mount Rainier will
 be climbed, parties will visit Spray
 Park and Spray Falls, 800 feet high.
 The Elvian Field, Grand Park and
 Summerland will be visited in turn.
 Many other shorter trips will be made.
 The climb of the mountain will require
 a bivouac camp at Steamboat
 Prow. From Moraine Park the party
 will proceed in a northwesterly direction
 to the Windthorpe Glacier, which
 will be crossed. Leaving this glacier
 by way of St. Elmo Pass, the party will
 cross the ridge to the Inter Glacier,
 which will be crossed. The party will
 proceed to the site of the temporary
 camp.

Ascent to Take Nine to 12 Hours.
 The next day the climb over the Emmons
 Glacier to the summit will be made.
 The ascent should take nine to 12
 hours, the descent four to six hours.
 If possible the return to Moraine Park
 will be made in the evening. On August
 14 the party will leave and return
 to Tacoma by the same route used on
 the trip in Tacoma will be reached on
 the evening of August 16.

H. H. Prouty, president of the Mazama
 Club, and a small party of climbers
 will pass the two weeks previous to
 the climb in exploring in the vicinity.
 The club will establish headquarters in
 Portland during July, where all details
 can be arranged. Plans of all details
 are in charge of the chairman of the
 outing committee, F. W. Benefield,
 114 East Twentieth street.

The Mazama Club extends an invitation
 to members of other mountain
 climbing clubs and to nature lovers in
 general to join the outing party. The
 cost of the trip will be about \$50 from
 Portland.

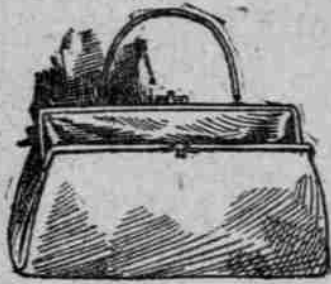
