

STEAMER PASSES OUT

Independent Lines to Carry Refugees for Half Fare.

OFFER MADE TO MR. BRYAN

Frank Bollam, Portland Agent, Sends Telegram to Secretary of State and Receives Answer Expressing Thanks.

Not to be outdone by big railroad corporations that have arranged to aid Mexican refugees by granting half rates from the border to various points in the United States, Frank Bollam, Portland agent for the independent steamship lines operating from here, as well as the turbine steamers Yale and Harvard, running between San Francisco and Southern California ports, has telegraphed Secretary of State Bryan that the fleet will carry refugees on the same terms as that offered by the Government.

Mr. Bollam received a reply last night from Secretary of State Bryan as follows: This department appreciates the generous offer referred to in your telegram of April 26. Copies of the telegram have been furnished to the War and Navy departments.
