Campaign for Full Weight Is Started by City Sealer.

VIOLATORS FACE ARREST

Consumers Asked to Notify Official When Short Measure Is Given. System to Determine Exact Amount Is Outlined.

The fate of the short-weight freman is sealed.

In face of the increase in ice prices,
City Sealer of Weights and Measures Jones announced yesterday that he will commence at once a vigorous campaign to require every dealer to deliver full weight. Dealers will be followed from house to house and their deliveries checked and arrests will be made im-

mediately upon discovery of short

mediately upon discovery of short weight.

As the opening gun in his campaign Scaler Jones has outlined for the benefit of consumers a method of weighing ice by measurement and has asked that all purchasers of ice use the system and report their findings if they are not absolutely correct.

Here are Mr. Jones' instructions:

When the ice is delivered, measure its length, its breath and its depth. Multiply the length by the breath and the total by the depth, which will give the number of cubic inches. There are 20 cubic inches of ice in a pound, so divide the total cubic inches by 30 and the result will be the number of pounds. A piece of ice 10 inches wide, 20 inches long and 14 inches deep would contain 2800 cubic inches which, would contain 2800 cubic inches which, divided by 30, would give 93, the num-

Upon discovering short weight ice the purchaser is requested to call the Sealer at the City Hall immediately. All manner of schemes have been de vised by Mr. Jones to check up on the deliveries of the ice men and arrests will be made in every instance where short-weight is found.

Mannix brought suit for \$13,000 due him, he charged, for legal services ren-dered in the suit brought by the Wakefield Company to collect from the city for the construction of two reservoirs at Mount Tabor. The verdict and in-terest totaled \$153,000, of which Mannix asked 10 per cent, less \$2000 that he has received.
