

ARRESTS IN GRAVEL INQUIRY POSSIBLE

Information Concerning City's Transactions Said to Be in Grand Jury's Hands.

SHORT WEIGHT IS CHARGED

Allegation Is Made Dealers Sold Material for Less Than Cost and Made Profit—Foot Blames Sand Combine.

Information gleaned by City Commission Bigelow and others from the records at the City Hall has been taken before the grand jury, it is said.

Among those involved in the investigation is Henry Foot, a sand and gravel dealer, who has been supplying the city with materials for sidewalk construction and street repair work.

Two experts have been going over the city's books for about three weeks in search of information. It is understood that some things have been found which have not been satisfactorily explained.

It has been said that certain dealers who purchase materials from big concerns and sell them to the city have sold the materials to the city for less than they actually paid for the material, and still have made money.

Another way those investigating say the city has been defrauded is by the dealers claiming to have made deliveries after hours.

Investigation of the sand and gravel transactions has extended to the books of the concerns producing the material. It is said evidence has been produced to show that actual purchases from these concerns have been for less than the purported deliveries to the city.

WETHERBY ESTATE SOUGHT

Title & Trust Company Asks to Be Appointed Administrator.

Another petition for the appointment of an administrator for the George Wetherby estate was filed yesterday by the Title & Trust Company, which requested its own appointment as a creditor of the estate.

Circuit Judge Cleeton will not make an appointment, he announced, until briefs are submitted on the point whether a creditor who took by assignment at the death of the debtor is a preferred creditor in the matter of appointment of an administrator.
