L. Wilbur Messer Speaks at Rotary Club After Tour of World.

L. Wilbur Messer, who has for five years been general secretary of the Chicago Y. M. C. A. and has just returned from a trip around the world, made a talk at the Rotary Club luncheon at the Multnomah yesterday about the social, economic and governmental conditions of India, China, Korea and the Philippines.

"It is interesting to note in the Orient the rapid development of a new era, due to Western civilization producing a new consciousness," he said.

"The Philippines already are lifted up to a condition of which we may be proud. The schools are modern even in the provinces and are taught by the finest type of teachers from our home colleges. Japan is making the best America can give and going it one better."
