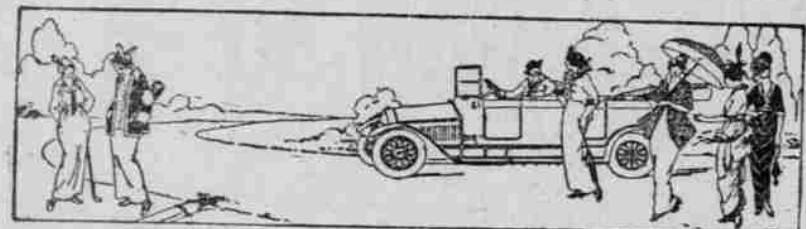

VETERANS ARE PLOUED

PRESIDENT'S REFUSAL TO SPEAK
MEMORIAL DAY CAUSE.

Wilson's Declination Based on Fact
That Mexican Situation Makes Talk
to Soldiers Inadvisable.

OREGONIAN NEWS BUREAU, Washington, May 28.—Old soldiers of the Grand Army of the Republic are speaking in unkindly terms of President Wilson because of his declination to speak at the Memorial day exercises to be held May 30 at Arlington Cemetery. For years it has been customary for the President, regardless of party, to participate in the ceremonies of that day, especially when Congress is in session and the President is in Washington. President Wilson declined, giving as his reason that he thought it inadvisable to speak to the old soldiers in view of the pending delicate Mexican situation.
