Today the game will start at 4 o'clock, owing to the parade. Score: Oakland, 4; Portland, 1.

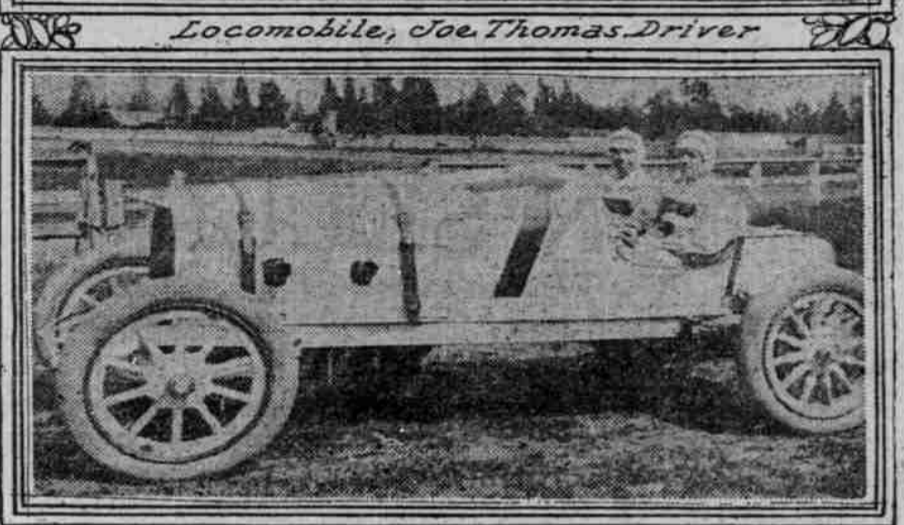
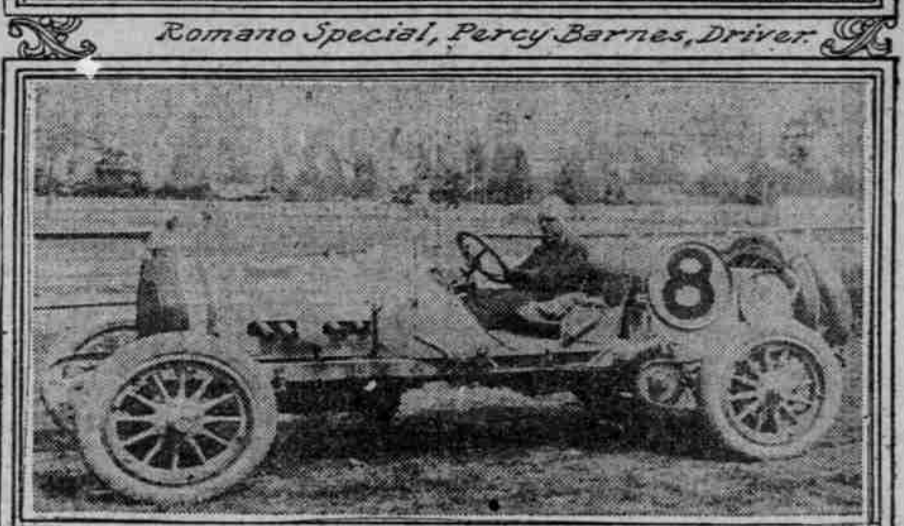
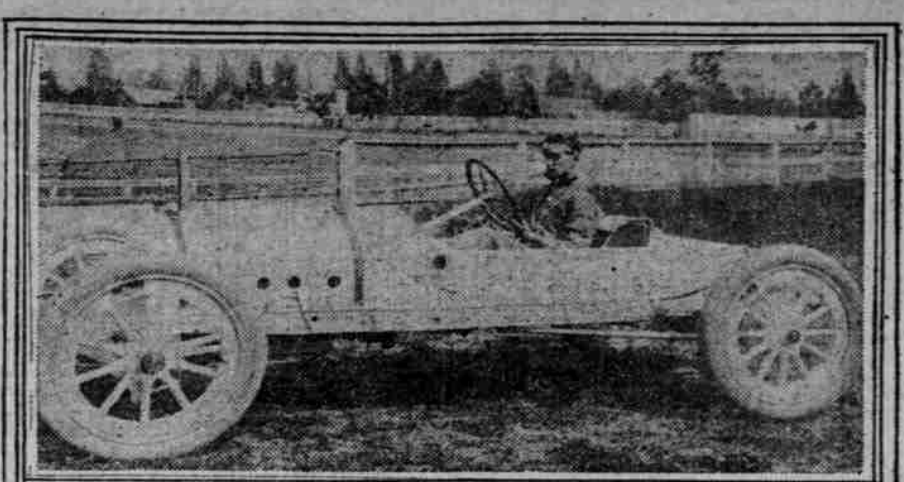
LOS ANGELES BLANKS SEALS
