F. I. Johnstone visited the transportation committee of the Chamber of Commerce immediately after he had registered from Klamath Falls...

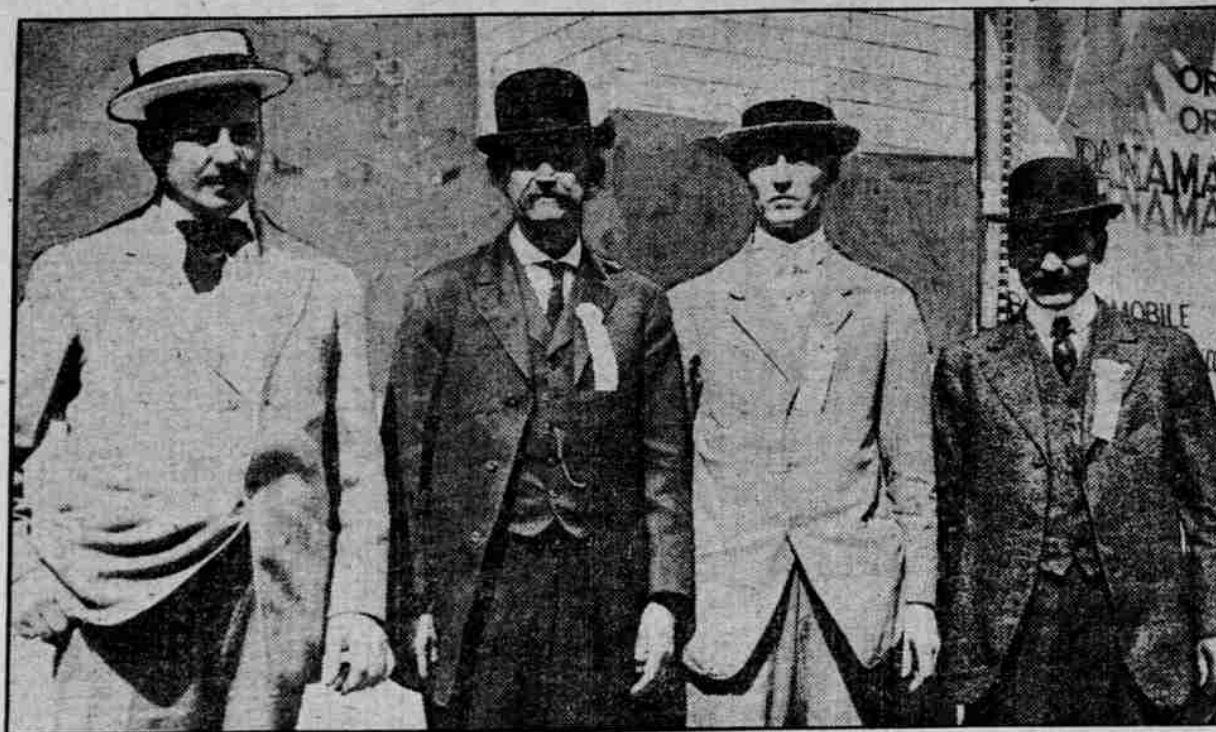
"Klamath Falls wants to trade in Portland and here as much as possible," he said, "and would trade here to a greater extent if the discriminatory railroad rates were removed..."
