Fresh grated horse radish, 50 cents a pint; tomatoes, 25 cents a box; savor (or curly) and red cabbage, 5 cents a head...

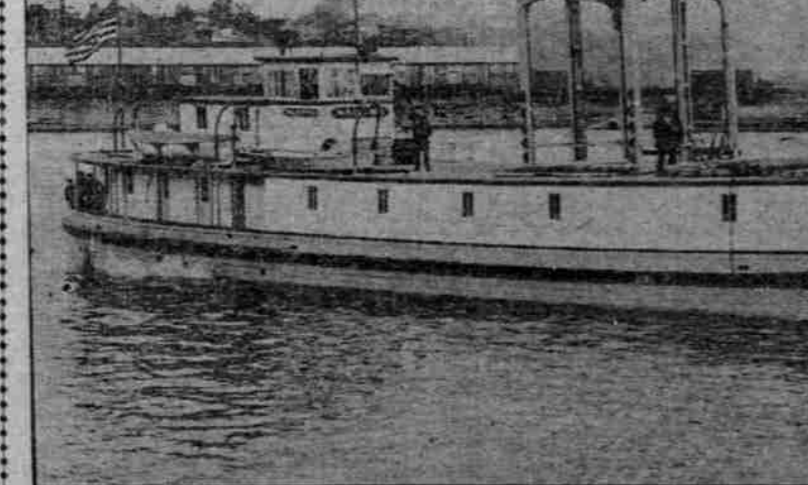
Crabs are from 15 to 25 cents each; shrimps, 15 cents and hard-shell clams, 5 cents a pound; mussels, three pounds for a quarter...

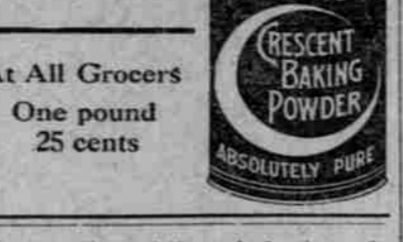
