MRS. VAUGHN'S SPECIAL RECIPES:

- SWEET POTATO CROQUETTES.**  
1 pint sweet potato pulp, 1 teaspoonful salt, 2 tablespoonfuls sugar, 2 tablespoonfuls melted crisco, 1/2 teaspoonful cinnamon, 1-3 cupful chopped almonds, 1 egg well beaten. Par-boil potatoes and when tender force through a sieve; add crisco and egg and seasoning. Allow to stand for several hours in a refrigerator. Shape into balls, dip in egg and then in crumbs and fry in crisco heated until a cube of bread will turn a golden brown in 40 seconds. Drain and use to garnish chicken dish.
- DIXIE BISCUIT.**  
2 cupfuls flour, 3 teaspoonfuls baking-powder, 1 teaspoonful salt, 1 teaspoonful sugar, 2 eggs, 1 cupful milk, 3 tablespoonfuls crisco. Sift together the dry ingredients. Rub in the crisco lightly; beat eggs and add alternately with milk. Roll out 1/4 inch in thickness and cut with biscuit cutter. Brush over with crisco and bake in a hot oven.
- DEVIL'S FOOD CAKE.**  
2 cupfuls granulated sugar, 3/4 cupful crisco creamed together, 4 eggs, yolks creamed with sugar and crisco, 1 cupful hot mashed potatoes, 1/2 teaspoonful nutmeg, 2 squares Baker's chocolate grated, 1/2 cupful milk, 1 cupful nut meats, 2 cupfuls flour, 2 teaspoonfuls baking-powder, 2 teaspoonfuls cinnamon. Cream together the sugar and crisco, then cream with the yolks of the eggs. Stir in the mashed potatoes, grated chocolate and nut meats. Sift together the flour, nutmeg and cinnamon and stir in alternately with the milk. Beat thoroughly, and lastly fold in the beaten whites of eggs.
- MOCHA ICING.**  
1-3 cupful crisco, 1 cupful confectioner's sugar, 1/2 teaspoonful salt, 1 tablespoonful strong coffee infusion. Cream crisco and add sugar gradually until all oily appearance has disappeared (it may require more sugar). As the mixture thickens, add the coffee one drop at a time, beating all the while. Flavor with 1 teaspoonful vanilla and spread on the cake.
