MRS. VAUGHN'S SPECIAL RECIPES:

BREAD TARTS.
1/2 cupful of bitter almonds, 2 tablespoonfuls citron, 1 teaspoonful cinnamon, 1 teaspoonful mace, 1 cupful sugar, 1 cupful rye bread crumbs, 1/2 glass claret wine, 1/4 glass currant jelly, 1 cupful Jordan almonds, 1/4 cupful raisins, 1 teaspoonful baking powder, 1 teaspoonful salt, 1/4 cupful crisco, Juice 1 lemon, whole of 6 eggs. Blanch and grind the almonds. Grate and sift the rye bread, cut the citron and raisins fine. Pour over them the currant jelly and claret wine. Cream and sugar and crisco. Add well-beaten yolks of eggs; juice and rind of lemon; then bread crumbs. Beat well for at least 5 minutes. Add dry ingredients, fold in well-beaten whites of eggs and bake in moderate oven in well-crisped pans.

CHOCOLATE MARSHMALLOW ROLL.
2 eggs well beaten, 1/4 cupful lukewarm water, 2 tablespoonfuls melted crisco, 1/2 teaspoonful sugar, 1 teaspoonful cream tartar. Sift into them 1 cupful granulated sugar, two squares Baker's chocolate, 1/4 cupful flour, 1/2 teaspoonful soda. Sift together the dry ingredients several times. Beat eggs together until light. Add sugar gradually, then the melted chocolate, and the lukewarm water, and two tablespoonfuls melted crisco, beaty fold in the dry ingredients. Bake in a moderate oven in thin sheets. Remove from pan on a damp cloth, spread with marshmallow filling and roll up as a jelly roll.

CHICKEN A LA KING.
2 cupfuls cold chicken cut in strips 1 inch long, 1 cupful sauted sliced mushrooms, 1/4 cupful blanched sliced almonds, 1/4 cupful pimento cut in strips, 2 tablespoonfuls crisco, 2 tablespoonfuls flour, blended with 1 cupful rich milk, and 1/2 cupful chicken stock, 1 teaspoonful salt, 1/4 teaspoonful white pepper, pinch paprika, just before adding chicken to this add and beat in evenly 1 egg, season with 1 teaspoonful Worcestershire sauce, add chicken and almonds. Allow to stand for 15 minutes or more in double boiler. When ready to serve add the mushrooms and pimentos. Serve in bread cases, patties, timbales or slices of toast.
