

LEADS MAINTAINED AS COUNTY GOES ON

Chamberlain Estimated to Win by 27,000 and Withycombe by 35,000.

PROHIBITION SWEEPS ALL

Democratic Candidate for Governor Has Lead in Six Counties—Drys Ahead by 24,366 Are Likely to Attain 34,000.

With approximately four-fifths of the vote of the entire state counted, George E. Chamberlain has a lead over E. A. Booth for the Democratic nomination of 22,108.

With the swinging into the dry alignment by Multnomah County in the later figures the prohibition forces have captured the vote of every county in the state.

Drys Lead by 24,366. The majority in favor of the measure with about 70 per cent of the vote returned is 24,366. At that ratio the amendment should have an affirmative plurality of about 34,000.
