MANY MARRIED MEN NOW NEED CHARITY

More Heads of Families Destitute Than in Eight Years, Says Mr. Manning.

RELIEF MEASURES NEEDED

Associated Charities Makes Earnest Appeal So It Can Be Ready to Give Aid After Holidays. Daily Demands Met.

"In the past eight years of work in organized charities there has never been before a condition where there were so many men with wives and families reduced by unemployment and other unforeseen circumstances to a condition of temporary destitution."

This condition is not, Mr. Manning asserts, confined to Portland alone, but is evident here as it is in other sections of the country and must be dealt with by such relief measures as can be had until the improvement of conditions removes the pressure.

Charity Must Bear Burden. "Organized charity will have to bear the burden of caring for these unfortunate people after the Christmas holidays and it is for this reason that the Associated Charities is making its earnest appeal for money for its relief fund."

While the Associated Charities is carrying on its relief work every day, during the holiday week there is naturally relief in the pressure upon it, owing to the vast number of temporary charitable movements that spring up and the many bits of relief work for Christmas day alone that are performed by individuals. The families in want, however, are not provided for for the whole year by the Christmas relief fund.

Case 72. Damp Cold Room Only Home. A woman and three little children are living in a damp, unhealthy room, without fuel sufficient to keep them comfortably warm. A great pool of water stands under the house and the many bits of relief work for Christmas day alone that are performed by individuals.

Case 73. Baby Sick; Disabled. In this family the baby, 2 years old, is desperately ill and the oldest boy, who is 18 years old, on whom the whole support of the family had fallen, is suffering from a broken arm and cannot work for a long time.

CHARITY DAY EFFECTIVE

At the Associated Charities, at 411 Commercial block, the grocery department reported its biggest day. Persons began arriving early with their bundles, dropping them at the door and making off with all possible speed, before the workers at the Associated Charities could obtain their names.
