CITY TO PAY CARPENTERS 34.—Carpenters employed by Multnomah County, hereafter will be paid the union wage scale of \$4 a day.

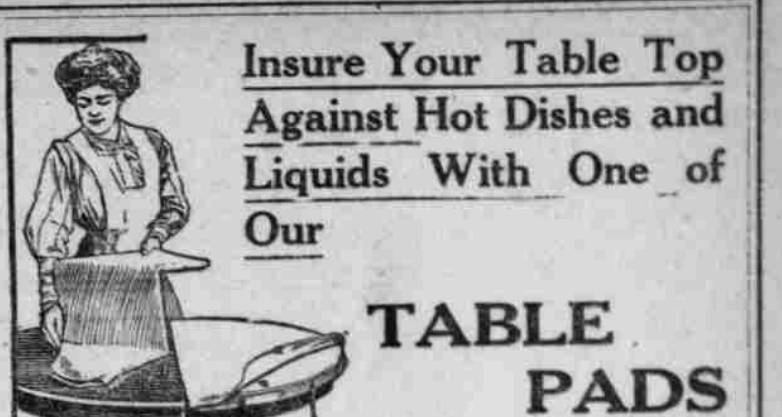
