SMELL SENSE VITAL. Trial of Two for Arson Is Based on Odors at Mill. USE OF PHOSPHORUS SHOWN. Nightwatchman and Employee Testify That Several Blazes Broke Out at Once—Detectives Probably to Go on Stand Today.

PROSECUTOR IS CHARGING THAT PHOSPHORUS WAS USED TO SET FIRE TO THE MILL. To start fire with phosphorus it is usually dissolved in carbon disulphide.

EMPLOYEES GIVE TESTIMONY. Testimony yesterday was chiefly by nightwatchmen and employees of the mill who were present when the fire broke out in several different parts of the mill.
