Long-time loans. Bankers prefer short-time paper. This is due probably to the influence of the war, but I believe the new Federal reserve system, which offers rediscounting privileges on short-time notes, too, is responsible.

Some Make Frequent Renewals. The prevailing rates of interest in New York for 60-day and 90-day loans are 4 and 4 1/2 per cent. Many railroads and industrial corporations are eager to borrow money for longer periods, but they are unable to get it on terms to suit them.

Mr. Baker expressed belief that as soon as the war is over business will become more settled and plenty of money will be available to finance the various enterprises that now need financing.
