Mrs. H. M. Smith Has New York Herald Extra on Lincoln's Death.

The 50th anniversary of the assassination of President Lincoln yesterday brought to light an old New York Herald extra, issued at 8:10 A. M., April 15, 1865. The paper is a single sheet of six columns, and has a crude two-column cut of Abraham Lincoln in the center. About half the page is devoted to details of the crime, and the remainder to discussion of the Civil War.

Besides a lengthy war editorial, the list proclamation of Jefferson Davis is given a prominent place.

This paper is a treasured possession of Mrs. Helen M. Smith, 2905 Fifty-third street, who bought it in Attica, N. Y., that morning.

Mrs. Smith was married in New York in 1860, and has been a resident of Ore-gon since 1876.
