Calm Deliberation, Says ex-President, Cannot Minimize Effect of Decision.

PEOPLE EVENTUALLY PAY

Plea Made That Those Who Must Endure Be Not Hurried Into Sacrifices; Toast to Wilson Is Proposed by Mr. Taft.

PHILADELPHIA, May 12.—Ex-President Taft urged patience and calmness in the present international situation and called on the citizens of the country to stand by President Wilson.

Under our Constitution the President conducts our foreign affairs until Congress finds it necessary to declare war. Upon him is the acute responsibility in such a crisis.

"But we must bear in mind that if we have a war it is the people who must pay, and therefore they should not be hurried into the sacrifice until it is clear that they wish it and know what they are doing when they wish it."

Responsibility on President. The President, Lincoln and McKinley in trying to avoid war. In the present situation it was imperative that he should know the opinion of the country which would regard his relations.

Taft Toast Is to President. "Before party, before ourselves, we are for our country. That is what he is doing. He will not surrender our country's right. It may be necessary that for 100 lives and the method of doing it."
