

SHIPPERS AND DOCK OWNERS IN CONFLICT

Equalization of Charges on Freight Handling to Be Considered Here Soon.

PORTLAND COST HIGHER

Chamber and Others to Present to Longshoremen Effect Rate Now Prescribed Has on Port and to Suggest Readjustment.

Representatives of the shipping and commercial bodies of Portland and of the longshoremen's organizations will hold a meeting in Portland within the next few days to consider the matter of equalization of freight handling on the waterfront here with the charges in other Pacific Coast ports.

This meeting will be attended by committees from the Portland Chamber of Commerce, agents of the steamship lines now operating on the Columbia River and the following representatives of the men who handle freight on the docks: T. V. O'Connor, president of the International Longshoremen's Union, John Neuman, president of the Pacific Coast division of that organization, and Andy Madsen, its secretary.

Business Men Favor Change. When the committee convenes Portland shippers will be ready to meet this question. They will have the active support of a large number of business men who are members of the Federation of Pacific Coast Waterfront Employers.

Charges Considered Excessive. For many years Portland shippers via water routes have been required to pay much larger amounts for unloading and loading of goods on the docks than is charged for the same service at either Seattle or San Francisco.
