Public Aid is Asked ERADICATION OF ELM-LEAF PEST SOUGHT BY OFFICIALS.

Trees Are Threatened With Destruction and City Is Unable to Attend All Cases.

Co-operation of the public in the campaign to eradicate the elm-leaf beetle which is threatening the destruction of elm trees in various parts of the city is asked by City Commissioner Baker and Park Superintendent Conville.

The beetle when full grown is about a half inch in length and about half as wide. It has shell wings folded on top of the body.

For people who want to take up the fight against the pest Park Superintendent Conville has prepared suggestions for spraying the pest rapidly destroying many trees and the city officials are unable to cover the entire city within a short time.

The spray used is made by mixing three pounds of arsenic to lead to 20 gallons of water. It is best after using this to spray the base and trunk of the trees with kerosene emulsion.
