

NEW HAVEN, Oct. 26.—The National Council of Congregational Churches to-day placed on record its bellef that armaments in the United States should armaments in the United States should not be greater than adequate National defense requires. The President and members of Congress were asked to recognize this principle and urged to bend their energies toward working cut, in co-operation with other gov-ernments, a plan for an international organization that will render a recur-rence of war imnossible
