

\$500,000 YET TO BE CUT IN SCHOOL LIST

Kindergarten Eliminated From Portland System by Action So Far on Budget.

TAX DEPRECIATION ISSUE

Drop in Value of Property in District Causes Estimated Loss of \$20,000 Revenues—Taxpayers' League Helping Slash Estimates.

When the school budget is complete, with further scaling down of proposed expenditures, it appears likely that the tax rate for school purposes will be fixed at 7 or 6.5 mills. This is as near as an estimate can be made now, as further meetings of the School Board will be held to pare the estimates.

The budget must be published first on November 10, according to law, so that the pruning knife and shears must be applied during the coming week. The would-be taxpayer is being kept off of somewhere around half a million from the present estimates, following already liberal reductions in the amounts proposed to be spent on the city school system during the coming year.

Schools Visited by Officials. A visit to a number of the schools was made yesterday by Chairman Blaney, of the Board; Superintendent Alderman and Leo Friede, C. Henri Labbe and Dr. A. J. Gieay, of the League committee.

Kindergarten Issue Eliminated. The action of the Board on the budget so far considered means the elimination of the kindergartens from the Portland schools. It had been asked that the kindergarten feature be incorporated and the necessary expenditures to carry it out had been placed in the budget tentatively.

Retrenchment Policy Outlined. Taxpayers of the district, and substantial ones at that, appear before the School Board at intervals and ask for substantial improvements such as extensions to the schools that involve much expense, and it is these items chiefly that will feel the pruning knife before the budget is complete.

CITY FILES WATER SUIT

Flow at Shepperd's Dell on Highway Demanded From Lumber Company.

Shepperd's Dell, on the Columbia Highway, will flow full of water from Young's Creek during the Summer months if the City of Portland wins a suit filed yesterday against the Bridal Veil Lumber Company. The suit demands a mandatory injunction prohibiting the lumber company from taking water out of Young's Creek far up in the Cascades and fluming it over a divide into Bridal Veil creek to increase the flow there during the dry season.

According to the complaint, which was filed by City Attorney LaRoché and E. E. Covert, the lumber company did not condemn the stream nor obtain riparian rights, but simply "appropriated" the water. Last May George Shepperd, who is a plaintiff with the city in this suit, gave Portland the 10 acres at Shepperd's Dell for park purposes. Mr. Shepperd still owns 80 acres adjoining.
