Departments Are in Accord and Mass of Information Has Been Collected.

KEPT INFORMED WILSON

Attorney-General to Have Principal Direction of Investigations of Criminal Activi-

ties Due to War.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 13.—The policy of the Department of Justice and Treasury Department in handling investigations of bomb plots, munition rectory explosions and similar matters was announced tonight in a statement authorized by Attorney General Greg-

ory and Secretary McAdoo.

It indicates that in the future the bureau of investigation of the Department of Justice is to be the main reliance of the Government in dealing with alleged criminal activities in this country connected with the European war.

Departments Are Co-operating.

The statement follows: The statement follows:

"In view of the widespread statements to the effect that the secret service force of the Treasury Department has been put in charge of the investigation of all bomb plots, ship-burnings, munition-factory explosions and the like, and the demonstration of whether the criminal statutes of, the United States have been violated, the Secretary of the Treasury and the Attorney-General authorize the statement:
