

TEMPESTS SWEEP EASTERN STATES

Trouble Due When 2 Storms Meet, and Atlantic and Lake Vessels Are in Peril.

BRIEF COLD IS FORECAST

Though Winds Rage and Dense Fog Hamper Traffic, Really Low Temperatures, Even in Alaska, Are Not on Map.

CHICAGO, Nov. 19.—(Special.)—The vicarious trail of a big storm lashed Chicago and vicinity all of today with a blizzard of snow, sleet and rain, followed by a blizzard of rain and sleet.

One boat was sunk off the Georgia coast, and one being towed in the Florida coast.

One man was killed in Pennsylvania when the wind tore down a structure, the flying debris striking him.

Lake Vessels Seek Shelter. All boats plying on the Great Lakes were speedily driven to shelter.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 19.—The two storms, which during the last 24 hours have moved toward each other from the South Atlantic coast and the Ohio Valley, have formed a junction over Western New York and Ontario.

ST. JOHNS, N. F., Nov. 19.—Several packets and sailing vessels, each carrying from 12 to 20 persons, were caught in the violent storm of the past few days and had not been reported to sight.

SECRET SERVICE TO WATCH FOR PLOTS

Departments Are in Accord and Mass of Information Has Been Collected.

WILSON KEPT INFORMED

Attorney-General to Have Principal Direction of Investigations of Criminal Activities Due to War.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 19.—The policy of the Department of Justice and Treasury Department in handling investigations of bomb plots, munition-factory explosions and similar matters was announced tonight in a statement authorized by Attorney General Gregory and Secretary McAdoo.

It indicates that in the future the bureau of investigation of the Department of Justice is to be the main reliance of the Government in dealing with alleged criminal activities in this country connected with the European war.

Departments Are Co-operating. The statement follows: "In view of the widespread statement that the secret service force of the Treasury Department has been put in charge of the investigation of all bomb plots, ship-burnings, munition-factory explosions and the demonstration of whether the criminal statutes of the United States have been violated, the Secretary of the Treasury and the Attorney-General authorize the statement:

"That the different departments of the Federal Government have been instructed to furnish and are furnishing to each other all information which will assist each department in performing the duties devolving upon it. No Disagreement Expected.

"That there is no disagreement between the departments as to their respective spheres and none is expected. "That with the exception of crimes relating to counterfeiting and the pay and bounty laws, the bureau of investigation of the Department of Justice is charged with the duty of investigating all information indicating violations of the criminal statutes of the United States, including conspiracies in violation of Federal criminal statutes, violations of interstate commerce statutes and passport frauds.

"That the instructions of the secret service of the Treasury are to turn over promptly to the bureau of investigation of the Department of Justice any data developed by the former which will assist the latter in carrying out such investigations."

The secret service began investigating alleged plots involving American neutrality shortly after the war began, and it has collected a mass of information bearing on activities of many kinds. Scores of reports have been filed with the Treasury and some of them are said to have gone up to President Wilson.
