CONVENTION TOPS NOT STATE CHARGE

Delegates Must Pay Own Expenses, Is Interpretation of New Oregon Laws.

MANY NAMES SUGGESTED

Primary Will Be May 19 and Republicans Are Announcing Candidacy to Represent Party. Democrats Not Keen.

Delegates from this state to the Republican, Democratic and Progressive National conventions will have to pay their own expenses under the new Oregon law, but candidates are fairly plentiful for all that.

Some question has arisen as to whether the expense provision of the 1911 law is not really still in effect, because the new law provides that all sections of the 1911 act "in conflict herewith are hereby repealed."

A legal opinion to the effect was given yesterday by Judge Charles H. Carey, who will be one of the Republican candidates for delegate from the state at large.

One eccentricity of the old law which still remains is that which makes it possible to elect 10 delegates, who have been elected on individual platforms.

Delegates will be elected at the primary election next May 19.

For delegates at large, however, Judge C. H. Carey will run, and so in all probability will ex-State Senator Fulton, C. P. Bishop and Russell Hawkins, W. P. Keady is mentioned, and so is ex-Senator Simon.
