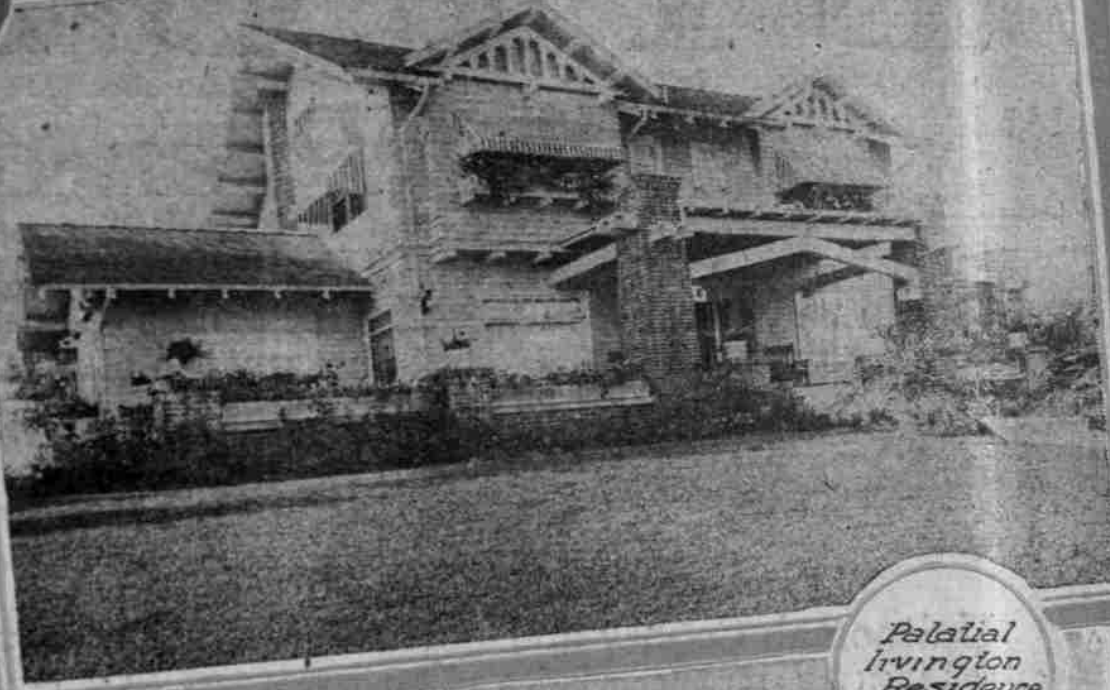

Whose gardens than gardens of dreamland are fairer—

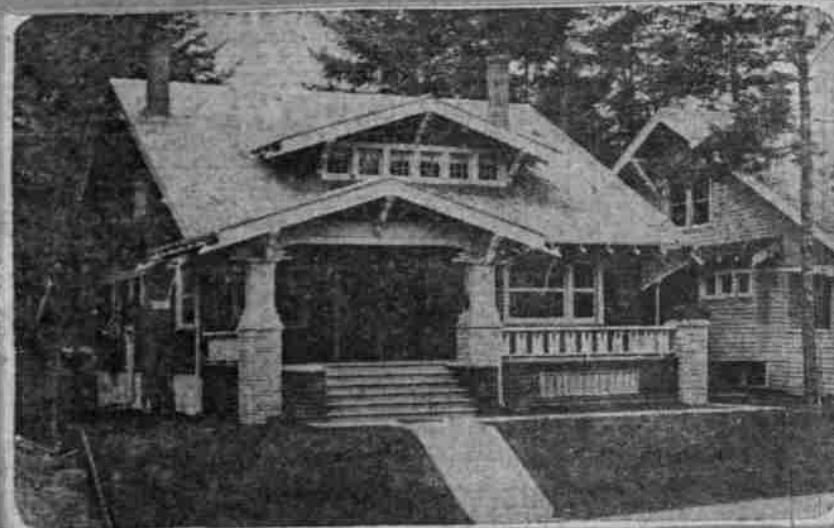
'Tis Portland, the City of Roses and Homes.
