

# HAWLEY EXPLAINS NEW CREDITS BILL

Main Purpose Is to Enable Farmer to Obtain Funds at Low Interest Rate.

## FOUR METHODS PROVIDED

Amount Borrowed Will Be Limited to Half of Valuation of Land. Measure Subject to Amendment in Committee.

OREGONIAN NEWS BUREAU, Washington, Jan. 4.—Just how the credit bill, drafted by the Joint Senate and House committees and introduced today, will operate with respect to the farmer is explained by Representative Hawley, of Oregon, a member of the Joint committee, and one of its most active members. This bill, said Mr. Hawley, is not to be jammed through in its present form, but will be regularly referred to the banking and currency committee of the two houses, where it will be subject to amendment, and when brought into the House and Senate it will be further open to amendment.

The bank will satisfy itself that the right valuation has been placed on the land. When the loan is approved and the mortgage offered as security found satisfactory, the land bank will send the money to the borrower.
