

RAIL-AND-LAKE INCREASE DE-CLARED UNJUSTIFIED.

ancellation of Tariffs Between New England and Middle Atlantic Points and West Is Ordered.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 11.—Proposed increases in class and commodity rates by rail-and-lake routes between New England and Middle Atlantic states points and the West were found unjustified today by the Interestate Commerce Commission. Increases proposed were about 5 per cent.

The Commission ordered cancellation of tariffs of railroads containing the increases, which provided rates for the bauls over the Great Lakes by about 19 operating boat companies.

The increases, the opinion points out. Were proposed for the purpose of maintaining the all-rail and the rail-and-lake routes before the 5 per cent case was decided in which increases were allowed in the all-rail rates and not in the others.

In the present case, it was contended, financial need of the boat lines is equal to that of the rail lines before the 5 per cent case decision, that the old relationship should be restored.
