Man Wanted at Winona, Wash., Is Arrested in Iowa.

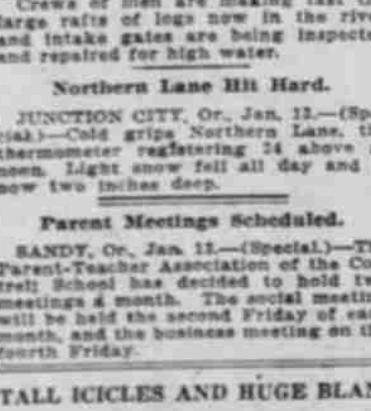
